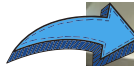


EDUCATION FOR AN INSPIRED LIFE

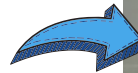
PROTECTION AND SAFETY

INTERNATIONAL DAY OF EDUCATION AND NATIONAL GIRL CHILD DAY FOR INDIA

A date focussed on observing both International Day of Education and National Girl Child Day for India.

In consonance with both pressing issues, it has been **FXBIS' mission to reach out to the girls of remote vulnerable forgotten places**, and back them to be self-dependent and independent-minded.

Initiatives such as Suraksha Education Centres (28 SECs spread across 12 states of India), forming adolescent school & community peer groups and conducting life-skill sessions form part of our strategy to raise the bar for girls' education, health, protection and safety. Promoting menstrual hygiene management in twelve government school students of Greater Noida, conducting life-skill sessions at with adolescent students of government school at Jaipur, and spreading awareness against trafficking to "kishori group" at village Barkutti in rural Ranchi are some other on-going initiatives. 7 such groups have been facilitated by FXBIS team in Ranchi.



For a country to have a bright future, society and family to flourish, women empowerment is essential. In ancient India women weren't treated the same way the men were, so in order for the country to develop, women must be given equal status as men. India is a country known for its cultural legacy, traditions, society, religion and geographical features from the ancient time.

At **FXB India Suraksha**, our mission to enable marginalised communities lead a life of dignity and self-reliance begins by catalysing their women towards economic and social empowerment. Women, besides children, hold centre point focus in all of our development projects created for rural or urban areas coz we realise that 'an equal world is an enabled world'. It is to make the women independent in all aspects of life be it mind, thoughts and making the right decisions without the societal and family restrictions. Empowering women is to bring equality in the social order in which men and women are both equals in all areas.

NUTRITIONAL DEMONSTRATION SESSION

When we change mindsets, we change behaviours which ultimately lead to change in the society's collective conscience. Violence against women and girls cannot be eliminated otherwise. The aforesaid adopted by **FXBIS teams pan-India** since inception - empower women psycho-socially and economically, to usher in a gender-equitable society. Promotion of health of mother and children has been one of the most important thrusts of the Family Welfare Programme in India.

Focussing on adequate and proper nutrition during the first 1000 days of child and maternal care, **FXBIS team in Manoharpur (Jharkhand)** conducted **nutritional demonstration sessions** at the anganwadi centres of Jamkundia village. Attended by over 60 pregnant & lactating mothers besides the anganwadi workers, the aim was on teaching simple and cost effective recipes to reduce the rampant malnutrition prevailing in the village. The National Population Policy (2000) recommended a holistic strategy for bringing about inter-sectoral co-ordination at the grass roots level by involving NGOs, Civil Society, Panchayat Raj Institutions and Women Self Help Groups in reducing maternal mortality.

SANITATION & HYGIENE
